There will also be a special performance for senior citizens only in the afternoon at 1.45pm for a 2pm start. We will be having a collection on this day to help fund our Nativity Animal visit on the 15th!

Tuesday 19th December – Pantomime Visit

We will be visiting the Cliffs Pavilion for our Pantomime Performance of Jack and The Beanstalk. The trip will be staffed and managed by school staff. Children should wear school uniform and may take sweets and non-fizzy drinks with them. Please provide these in a carrier bag clearly labeled with your child's name. We will leave school at 1.00pm and will leave the theatre at 4.45pm and so anticipate returning to school for about 5.45pm. Parents will be required to collect pupils from the school hall on our return so we can ensure everyone's safety. We will be travelling by coach, no booster seats etc are required. Pupils not taking part in the visit will need to be in school as usual and collected in the normal way. We will attempt to text parents with updates of times.

Wednesday 20th December - Party Day

On the last day of term staff and pupils will be visiting the church during the morning for a traditional service. Then in the afternoon **it's party time**. We will have a special party menu lunch of Special Chicken Nuggets (vegetarian nuggets available). There will also be Macaroni Cheese as a blue option, which will all be served with chips and beans followed by chocolate sponge and custard or mango smoothie, no party food required!
